## PERMIT PROVISIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ISSUANCE

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, this permit is granted to allow performance of the specific work described herein. The following standard provisions and any included special provisions shall govern:

- (1) The applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City, its employees and its agents, from any cost, claim, suit, liability and/or award which might come, be brought, or be assessed, because of the issuance or exercise of this permit, or because of any adverse effect upon any person or property which is attributed to the partially or entirely completed works of the Applicant. Accomplishment of the permitted work, or any part thereof, by or on behalf of the Applicant shall bind such Applicant to abide by this permit and all its conditions and provisions.
- (2) Upon request by the City, Applicant, at its expense, shall alter or modify its utility installation to allow improvements to be constructed, altered or maintained by or at the direction of the City within the public right of way.
- (3) No open cutting for a crossing will be allowed where the pavement is less than 12' in width unless the City has granted permission for a detour. Wherever the pavement is opened, the spoil shall be hauled away and the trench shall be backfilled with sand or gravel and compacted in layers not to exceed 12-inches. The pavement removed for a road crossing shall be replaced as per the City's specifications.
- (4) When one-way traffic or a detour is used, the Applicant shall provide ALL NECESSARY SIGNS, FLAGMEN AND LIGHTS required according to the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices". When a detour is allowed, local newspapers shall be notified by the Applicant within sufficient time in advance of the work being started to allow timely publication of the detour information in such newspaper.
- (5) Any trenching, tunneling, or excavating shall be performed in accordance with the requirements of OSHA and the Wisconsin Department of Safety & Professional Services, and any applicable local regulations.
- (6) A copy of this approval, along with any plans and special provisions, shall be available on the job site.
- (7) The location where an excavation is made shall be properly guarded during daylight, and shall be properly guarded and lighted overnight, all in a manner approved in advance by the City.
- (8) The street, sidewalk, alley and/or terrace shall be restored and left in as good or better condition than existed when the work was commenced.
- (9) All restoration of street, sidewalk, alley and/or terrace affected by this permit shall be completed within (20) twenty calendar days of the closing of the excavation, at the expense of the Applicant. In the event work is not completed within this time limitation, the City, at its option, may either complete the work and bill the entire cost of the work to the Applicant or revoke this permit.
- (10) All restoration work, including landscaping, shall be guaranteed for a period of (4) four years.
- (11) Upon completion of the work, the Applicant shall file a written notice with the Permitting Authority.
