There was a motion by Streif and a second by Hagen to approve a one-time monetary payment to show appreciation for adjusting normal job descriptions duties & performances due to circumstances out of their control to Debi Heisner, Clerk Treasurer, Cindy Smith, Janitor and the 6 Police Officers of the City of Fennimore Police Department in the amount of \$2500 each.
