

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FENNIMORE, GRANT COUNTY,
WISCONSIN HELD ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 15TH, 2025**

The Regular Council meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Ryan Boebel at 5:30 p.m.

Roll Call was taken with the following alderpersons answering present: Adam, Kretschman, Roth, Strack, Streif, and Hagen. Director of Public Works Anthony Downing, City Clerk-Treasurer, Ashley Edge, and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer, Ashley Mumm were also in attendance.

Agenda: Proof in the form of a certificate of public notice given as required by Section 19.84, Wis. Stats., as to the holding of this meeting, was presented by the Deputy Clerk-Treasurer. Motion by Streif, second by Strack to approve the proof of posting and agenda. Motion carried 6-0.

Presentation of accounts and other claims against the city: There was a motion by Streif and a second by Kretschman to approve the 11/28/2025 Council claims with the breakdown of bills to their respective accounts for a total of \$796,768.48 with City bills at \$652,330.83, Utility bills at \$126,428.27 Sewer bills at \$18,009.38, TIF-CDBG bills at \$0, and Capital Projects at \$0. Gross Payroll amounts for 11/28/2025 were \$68,594.48 with \$38,682.53 for City, \$20,102.83 for Utility and \$9,809.12 for Sewer. Gross Payroll amounts for 12/12/2025 were \$69,981.98 with \$40,044.16 for City, \$20,677.70 for Utility and \$9,260.12 for Sewer. Motion carried on a roll call vote 6-0.
